Stephen Triffitt is Frank Sinatra

Stephen Triffitt debuted as Frank Sinatra at the Sands Casino Hotel in Atlantic City, where he spent seven weeks in 2000/2001 starring in Jeff Kutash's "The Main Event", a show that traced the story of Frank Sinatra's life through his songs. The same show took Stephen to Las Vegas, the home of the legendary Rat Pack. For three and a half months, he wowed audiences at the Venetian Hotel with his uncanny resemblance to Frank Sinatra.

Stephen's successful career performing as Frank Sinatra in Europe began right in London's West End: from 2003 onwards, theatregoers flocked to see "The Rat Pack - Live from Las Vegas", a production that captivated London audiences for many years. Stephen toured Canada, the Netherlands and the USA with the show, which was nominated for an Olivier Award. Stephen sang the theme songs for the film "Suzie Gold" and the TV series "Not Going Out", which was shown on BBC1. Later, he created his solo tour "Stephen Triffitt celebrates Frank Sinatra", taking it on the road five times.

He has sung regularly at summer concerts such as Beaulieu, Audley End and Kenwood, and performed with the London Symphony Orchestra and the BBC Symphony Orchestra in "Friday Night is Music Night". He starred in the revival of Frank Sinatra's TV show "One for my baby", as well as the "Sinatra Live at the Sands Concert" tour - a new production of the "Sinatra Live at the Sands" album. He also sang with Mick Jagger, Jools Holland and Brian May at Bob Geldof's 50th birthday celebration.

Mark Adams is Dean Martin

Before this father of four turned to acting, appearing in films as well as TV and theatre productions, he was a sports and drama teacher.

His career began in 2003 with the role of Dean Martin in the original West End cast of “The Rat Pack – Live from Las Vegas” at the Royal Haymarket Theatre. The show ran there for several years, was nominated for an Olivier Award and is still one of the most successful shows ever seen in the West End. When the show re-opened at the Adelphi Theatre, Mark was one of the original cast members; he also played Dean Martin in the North American première of “The Rat Pack” in Toronto. The Rat Pack show opened doors for Mark all over the world, leading him to develop a tribute show in 2007 entitled “Dean Martin – That’s Amore” which he dedicated to the great artist, taking on the title role himself. He has also performed as Dean Martin at the London Palladium, the Royal Albert Hall, Casino Barcelona and in his spiritual home, Upton Park, in front of 34,000 West Ham fans. In addition, he has played the great American entertainer on TV shows such as “G.M.T.V.”, “This Morning” and “Saturday Swing”, as well as on many cruise ships.

Mark’s other West End credits include roles in musicals such as “Mutiny”, “Oliver!”, “Romance, Romance”, “Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat”, and Jerry Herman’s “Mack and Mabel”. He played *Jeff Barry* in the British tour of “Leader of the Pack” and also appeared as *Emile de Becque* in “South Pacific”, *David Baxter* in “Tales My Lover Told Me” and the narrator in “Chaplin, His Life and Music”.

British television roles include *Phil Thompson* in the series “Doctors” and appearances in TV shows such as “Eastenders”, “London’s Burning” and “American Voices”. He has also appeared in films such as “Paracelsus”, “Jesus Christ Superstar” and “The Big Swap”.

In terms of music, he can be heard not only on the original cast album and live DVD of “The Rat Pack – Live from Las Vegas” but also on his album “Losing Grace”, with songs written by John Hayes. He recently recorded an album with songs written by Nicky Campbell.

Mark played semi-professional football for several years and is now a qualified football trainer in England.

George Daniel Long is Sammy Davis Jr.

George has spent ten years interpreting the role of Sammy Davis Jr. and was one of the first artists to devote himself to portraying the legendary entertainer. He trained in musical theatre at the London Studio Centre. During this period he gained his first stage experience in musicals such as “Hair”, “The Cotton Club”, “Carmen Jones” and “Miss Saigon”.

Shortly after completing his training, he left England to perform as the lead singer in “Sebastian’s Caribbean Carnival” at Disneyland Tokyo – the first British artist to work there. He returned to the British stage with roles in “Fame”, “Magic of the Musicals”, “Music of the Night” and “Five Guys Named Moe”, and also performed in these productions in Sweden and Malaysia.

He played the role of Sammy Davis Jr. in the original West End cast of “The Rat Pack – Live from Las Vegas” and toured twice with the show. “The Rat Pack” was nominated for an Olivier Award – an honour shared by two other shows in which George has appeared. “Porgy & Bess” and “The Royal Hunt of the Sun”, both directed by Trevor Nunn, were also nominated for the prestigious theatre prize. He subsequently performed as *Mr. Higgins* in Jude Kelly’s revival of “Carmen Jones” and *Bill Jukes* in “Peter Pan”, as well as *Dinero* and *TJ* in the original cast of the West End show “Sister Act – The Musical” and *Ritchie Valens* in “The Winter Dance Party”.

He has appeared on television shows such as “Top of the Pops” and “Saturday Swings” and worked as a dancer and choreographer with artists and bands such as Boy George, Westlife and Mica. He was also assistant choreographer at the Oxford Dance Theatre.

Long can be heard on albums including “The Rat Pack – Live from Las Vegas” and “Sister Act – The Musical”, as well as his solo album “Me and My Shadow”.

In addition to his huge singing and acting talent, he has discovered another passion: in the past few years, Long completed a diploma in garden design and landscaping at the English Gardening School and now heads his own U.K. garden design company, Well Grounded Gardens.
